Summer Camp for 2025

Dear parents and church members,

As the colder weather rolls in we are already thinking of summer and making preparations for camp next year. We absolutely love going to both youth and kids camp and want to continue making memories, having great fellowship with other churches, and having a week dedicated to God and our relationship with Him. In order to do that, we are going to be making some changes that will help make camp more affordable.

Firstly, the camp price will be one amount regardless of church membership, as it was in years past. For the summer of 2025, youth camp will cost \$245, and kids camp will cost \$380. Every month there will be a letter sent out to every individual who is signed up for camp with how much they still owe, and if you are paying in installments, roughly how much should be paid to the church at that point in the year.

Secondly, the way that we will be handling fundraisers will be shifting with this new plan as well. Going forward, any money earned by fundraisers will be granted to those who show up and help during the event regardless of church membership. The funds will be divided equally between youth and children (or their parent/family member for those who are in 3rd-6th grade) for each fundraiser. For example, if \$500 is earned at a fundraiser and there are 5 volunteers helping at the event, then each person will have \$100 put towards their camp total. If the students' camp cost is already paid for and they still volunteer, they will choose who to donate those funds to and help reduce another person's cost of camp. For clarification, this does mean that if an individual helps out at events, then their total cost could be down to \$0.
